

# Model Storyboard – Resort Website.

Create a Storyboard for your “Resort Website.” A Storyboard is a drawing of each page that will be a part of your “Resort Website.” **The drawings must be done using Google Draw.** Your Design Document needs to show the following.

1. Your Storyboard is a brief summary of the information that will be on your website (*Your website will be detailed!*).
2. Show how your website will be organized. At a minimum, it will have a ‘title’, at least one ‘image’, and an ‘explanation’. This information should be lined up in a table with at least one row and two columns. (*See example below.*)
  - a. At least one page needs to contain a table with three images. (*See example below.*)
3. Somewhere on each page there should be a Navigation Bar that contains the links to the other web pages. The Navigation Bar will also be in a table and organized in at least 1 row and 4 columns. (*See example below.*)

Note 1: Your website is not locked into the design you present on your storyboard. Your website should continue to change as you get new ideas as you build it.
